## Reception Summer 2 Transport and Travel

Our Topic for the next half term will focus on transport and travel. We will look at different ways to travel and transport; naming them and comparing these to travel in the past. We will also discover what seaside holidays are like in the past compared to now. We will share our own experiences of the sights and sounds of the seaside and look at how these have changed compared with the Victorian times.

Other key learning this half term will be ordering key events in chronological order, developing confidence in new activities and showing independence, resilience, an perseverance in the face of a challenge and to safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour and texture to create a Punch and Judy Puppet.

## English

Use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems and during role play. Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words. Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

## Maths

Pupils will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will secure knowledge of number facts through varied practice, as well as recalling doubles and number bonds.
