

Year 3 - Carnival

During this topic, our key learning will be about where carnival originated. We will look at the people who were enslaved to work in the Caribbean plantations and how carnival is part of their heritage.

We will also be learning about how the parts of the flower work so that they can reproduce more flowers. In PSHE we will be learning about how the world around us can influence our choices.

In English, we will be writing a 'People's History' and we are hoping that a famous face from the past will pay us a visit. We will also be doing some writing to support our transition to Year 4.

In Maths, we will be making sure we are confident with our calculation methods and looking at Fractions.

Home-learning will be given each Friday and due in by the following Thursday. Spellings will also be given. We ask all children to read five times a week. Completion of home-learning and reading earns extra Dojo points.
