- This year's figure was slightly down on last year. On entry to Reception, the children completed the DfE Baseline Assessment. None of the 58 children who completed their reception year here at Meadowfield passed the Reception Baseline Assessment.
- There was an unusually high level of SEN in this cohort with 14 children on the EHCP pathway by the time they completed their reception year.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check (PSC)

- This year's results saw a rise of 14 percentage points. Lots of extra time and resources were invested in the teaching of phonics this year and this resulted in a positive outcome for this cohort.

- Again, as with Year1 this year saw a rise in the number of children scoring 80%+ in the Phonics Screening Check. There was a rise of 14%.
- This means that 72% of the children in the current year 3 cohort have passed their PSC. We have identified the children in KS2 who did not pass the KS1 PSC and they are being assessed for reading. Where necessary they will receive bespoke RWI tutoring to help them make greater progress in all areas of the curriculum.

- Another successful year. Results are above early indications for the National average of ~ 37% and are very strong when compared to other schools within the trust. Trust schools average was 46%. Only four schools within the trust scoring higher.

- Tutoring – huge impact on outcomes – Maths SS rose from 92 to 104 and EGPS SS rose from 92 to 102 – to run again this year in a similar fashion.
- Lexia Reading Intervention– positive impact across KS2 – Y6 saw average Reading SS rise 11 points from 90 to 101.
