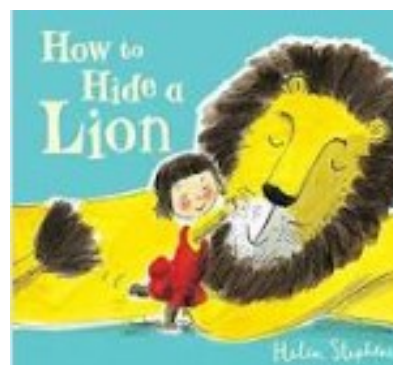


Our **book review** this week comes from Mrs Brown, one of our school governors!

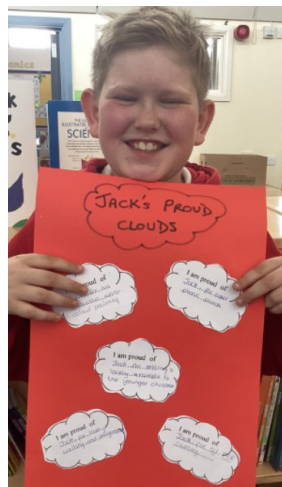
